

ESTABLISHING PRIVATE FAMILY CEMETERIES

- The cemetery cannot be within 500 yards (1500 feet) of a public or private hospital or medical facility without first having approval from the county Board of Supervisors and/or the City Municipality governing officers if located within their jurisdiction for proposed cemetery location.
- You must obtain a survey description of proposed cemetery property land.
- The Board of Supervisors are authorized to establish or designate the location of the private family cemetery.
- A deed must be recorded designating the plot of land into the family cemetery name.
- Only the plot of land with the cemetery designation will be exempt from property taxation.
